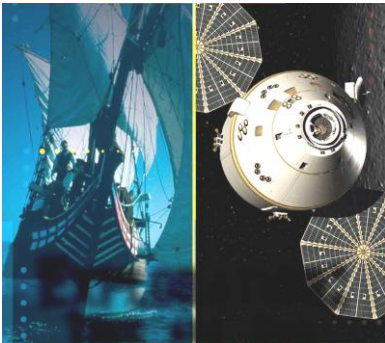
Destination Mars.....DSM - 18



If you accept this mission you will gain knowledge and awareness about the process of exploring Mars. The orbits of Earth and Mars affect traveling there. Through an orbit activity you will begin to understand that timing is very important especially when humans eventually travel to and from this mysterious planet. We will examine various soils similar to how scientists are examining Martian soils through robotic means. As scientists look for evidence of life on Mars they focus much of their search where volcanic heat and water interacted early in the geologic history of the planet. The activities on volcanoes, mapping river channels and craters reinforce these processes. These will lead directly to a set of simple experiments that help students develop an understanding of the microbial life scientists have searched for in the past and will be searching for in the near future. The camp will culminate with the development and building of a Mars Base Settlement.

Exploration: Then & Now - Part 1.....1EXP - 8



Humans, by nature, have a hunger to find new frontiers and a strong desire to establish a permanent presence in unexplored territories. NASA's Vision for Space Exploration calls for humans to return to the Moon by 2020, paving the way for eventual journeys to Mars and beyond. This mini-camp is divided into two parts which examines four themes and compares exploration of the past and present. It focuses on the settlement of Jamestown, the first permanent English-speaking colony which led to the formation of our country and NASA's plans to return to the Moon and reach for Mars. Each lesson consists of several student activities some of which include: Items I Need to Survive, Ranking Survival Items, Transportation & Navigation Activities, How Fast Can I Go, Does it Rain on the Moon and many more.

REGISTRATION DUE DATES

WHAT HAPPENS IF ENROLLMENT IS LOW?

If enrollment is low the camp may be cancelled. Should this happen you will be notified before camp. A full refund of the tuition will be issued ***NOTE: Refunds could take up to 6 to 8 weeks to be issued with no exceptions!***

DROP - OFF / PICK - UP

An adult must escort the student to and from the classroom and sign the child in and out of each camp session. If the child will be arriving without an adult we need to know this and how they will arrive. ***As mentioned above parents are invited at no extra charge.***

GUIDELINES & STUDENT CONDUCT

Staff will supervise your child at all times. Students may not leave the camp classroom without permission. They must follow the directions of the instructor at all times. If any incidents occur our policy requires that disruptive students be asked to leave the camp. We will call a parent/guardian to pick up the child immediately. They may return for the next session, but if another incident occurs the student will be dismissed for the rest of the camp. ***In the event that this should happen be aware that there is no refund for any of the days the child is dismissed from the camp.***
